Is a pilot project initiated by the European Union (EU). It aims at helping new entrepreneurs to acquire relevant skills for managing a small or medium-sized enterprise (SMEs) by spending time in a business in another EU country. It contributes to improving their know-how and fosters cross-border transfers of knowledge and experience between entrepreneurs. Erasmus for Young Entrepreneurs is financed by the European Commission and operated across 21 EU countries including Spain.

#### **Junta de Andalucia - €67 million in Grant Aid**

Keeping the best until last, The Junta de Andalucia has allocated €67 million for 2009 towards the creation, consolidation and modernization of autonomous businesses. Three main categories have been identified for funding; professionals linked to the advancement of innovation and technology for businesses and professionals linked to industry in strategic sectors. The monies will be distributed as a set up cost for new businesses in the amount of €3,000 and then up to €14,000 towards other costs. In the case of existing businesses, the amount allocated will be up to €10,000 to modernize the business. More information will be available as soon as the grants appear in the Official Bulletin.
